Harnessing the power of an outsider's perspective, Designer-Series Crystals are created by some of the world's preeminent thinkers, doers, and visionaries.

This year's visionary, Chris Bangle, shifted how we see Crystal Design, transporting us to a whole new half dimension.

PARADIGM

ILLUSIONS DESIGNED BY CHRIS BANGLE

Chris Bangle is no stranger to shifting perspectives. The now legendary former BMW Chief of Design, who left the company in 2009 to pursue other design passions, was famed for aggressive, emotional car designs. He's no stranger to controversy either. Small wonder his ability to reconceive habitual design elements have made him a perfect candidate to imagine crystals for Swarovski's Designer Edition Series that are both evocative and dimension defying.

During his tenure at BMW, Bangle designed cars that "strategized emotion." Understanding better than anyone else in the industry that car purchases are emotional decisions first, Bangle designed automobiles that looked fast and aggressive, even while parked. Today, his influence can be seen everywhere. Cars that Bangle designed more than a decade ago still seem contemporary and even some of his more provocative designs, such as the infamous E65 7 Series, have not only been vindicated, they now seem eerily futuristic. And if indeed imitation is the sincerest form of flattery, a look at the latest models at any international car show will attest that Bangle knew exactly what he was up to, even if others couldn't recognise it at the time.

Holding Bangle's Designer Edition Series Crystals in the hand, one is reminded of the evocative, multi-dimensional nature of his designs. His tilted take on crystal geometry manages to exude both space and dimension, even while appearing intrinsically flat, while his unique take on crystal forms compresses the third dimension along its axis, leaving behind a decidedly 2.5D feel

in a crystal that nevertheless retains volume. The sense of mystery this creates, while encouraging his audience to imagine the forms as they might have been before tilted, make the stones feel both exigent and forward thinking.

Since leaving BMW, Bangle has relocated his creative endeavours to the Piemonte Region of Italy where he has set up his own studio for collaborative design, aptly named Chris Bangle Associates Srl. Today, Bangle shares his experiences of a lifetime working in design and innovation by travelling the world to lecture, teach design and consult with clients.

Bangle once said that a "car designer is really a sculptor." While it's hard to imagine the smooth lines of elegant luxury cars could be chiselled from rock, the crystals he's designed for Swarovski are reminiscent of a sculpture park, though on a much smaller scale. On the grounds of the Piemonte estate, Bangle and his associates indeed design numerous large-scale sculptures that serve as inspiration. It's no surprise then that each of his fancy stones, titled Tilted Chaton, Tilted Spike and Tilted Dice, all feel like small works of art and inspiration.

Tilting perspectives with more than just crystals, and with the expansion of his amazing new facility for collaborative design, Bangle will continue to invite clients, critics and audiences into his world of alternative wonder.

DESIGN DIRECTIONS

Jewelers experiment with novel plating and heating techniques to convert traditional precious metals - including gold and titanium - into a new unexpected array of shades, essentially redefining luxury jewelry.

With the rise of the Megatrend - Female Shift designs celebrate the power and strength of the female form, conveyed in bold yet feminine design lines.

Jewelry is designed to balance the body using the healing properties of crystals and the mysticism of metals.

Drama is added to design with fairy-tale inspired jewelry pieces that explore new hand platforms.

Metallic finishes have a mysterious iridescence with blends of green, blue, silver and violet, creating magical yet esoteric pieces.

JEWELRY DESIGN BY ANDY FARROW

An English designer currently based in the UK, Andy Farrow initially studied graphic design, but at the end of his degree he realized that he wanted to use his hands and not be in front of a computer every day. After his graduation, and inspired by his 11-month travel sojourn, Andy began creating small structures that started to resemble jewelry. In 2004, he began a role with jewelry-designer Erickson Beamon until 2007.

During that time, Andy was asked to create a piece for Swarovski to feature in their Unbridaled coffee table book. Thus began his love affair with crystal. After leaving Erickson Beamon, Andy worked as a freelance jewelry designer, collaborating on costume jewelry for operas as well as catwalk pieces for fashion designers such as Vivienne Westwood. Over the years, he has created many pieces for fashion designers, costume designers, and worked for Swarovski on various projects, including a Runway Rocks piece. Today, Andy works mainly on commission in addition to having a small selection of specialized pieces in Browns Bride London.

It is possible to order two-colored motifs. You can choose from the Crystal Galuchat standard effects (see color matrix) \rightarrow one color for both crystal balls (3.5mm and 2.5mm) and one color for the round uncut crystals. Both crystal balls (3.5mm and 2.5mm) must have the same color.

It is not possible to mix three different colors.

Enlarging a small sketch results in blurred lines which will make it difficult to correctly reinterpret the design. You can send your motif files via email or on a CD-ROM. If sending a sewing pattern, please include the whole pattern instead of cut-outs. Crystal Galuchat can be applied with a standard heat press. Due to the height of the product, it must be applied from the back and with very high pressure. In addition to the standard ironing aids such as Teflon® foil (art. 9010/003) or a pressing cloth, use a silicone ironing pad/foam (art. 9010/002) to compensate for the height.

When using a transfer film for positioning purposes, start by ironing the product with that film for 10 seconds at the chosen temperature (see parameter overview below). Let the product cool down for a moment, remove the film carefully and conduct the proper application process following the recommended time span. Make sure not to reduce the required time by the time used for the pre-ironing step!

The following parameters provide an overview on how to apply this product onto different fabrics. Rose Pins are often applied with a fly press or a semi- or fully-automatic attaching machine. When multiple Rose Pins of one or different sizes are applied at once (e.g., to create a Rose Pin motif), the use of a Rose Pin mold/press is recommended. Please acquire the required masks/mold directly from the supplier (Gruppo Meccaniche Luciani).



1 Put the first PVC mask onto the lower part of the mold.



2 Sieve Rose Pins into the mask with the claws pointing upwards. Use one mask for each Rose Pin size and repeat the sieving step with all masks.



3 After having sieved all Rose Pins into the mold, remove the masks.



4 Put the fabric onto the lower part of the mold.



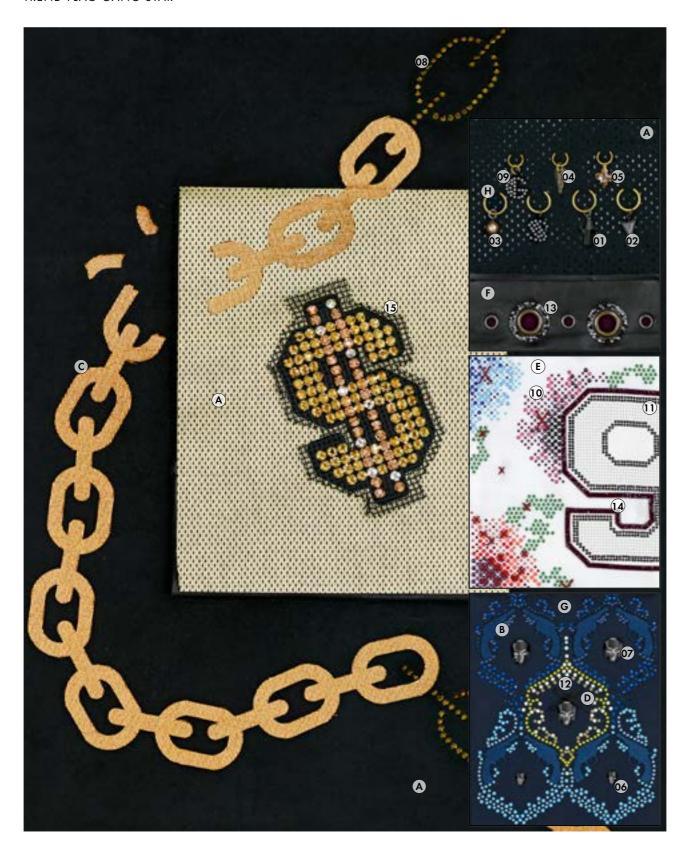

To be entirely safe customers respectively drycleaners usually take off Sew-on Stones, Buttons, etc. of bigger size before cleaning and re-apply them afterwards.
